The Bikers And Needy Children Foundation Vendor Application Procedures

ELIGIBILITY: All applicants must be the owner of their vendor business. All applicants must complete an *Accident Waiver And Release of Liability Form* and return it with this completed vendors application. Failure to do so and you will not be allowed to vend at the event. All vendors are responsible for their own insurances and liability coverage. The B.A.N.C. is not responsible for vendors, or their properties.

DESCRIPTION: Please describe what you vend on the application form.

VENDOR'S EVENT FEE: Currently there is a \$25 fee (per event) due with the application, NO EXCEPTIONS. The fee is not refundable if you do not show up, or if the event closes early due to weather. The fee will be refunded only if BFBF cancels the event in entirety.

All Vendor applications must be turned in ASAP, so we can reserve your space. Please, indicate which event you wish to vend at.

FYI: Limited camping is available for vendors.

Electricity: A \$15 fee for electricity per vendor if needed, payable at the time application is submitted. Explain in detail your exact electrical needs. **Bring your own extension cords. We will not provide any cords for you. Generators are allowed.**

Spaces: If you have an unusual sized tent or booth, please indicate its' dimensions. Otherwise all vendor spaces are 10x10. If your camper is part of your booth it is considered oversized. This is very important because every available foot is needed to lay out spaces correctly. Set up is outdoors on grassy and possibly muddy ground. If you cannot set up on a slight incline you must indicate so on your booth description. Bring all your own display materials (chairs, tables, etc.), tarps and canopies. Booths are the sole responsibility of the Vendor. You must lock up your merchandise at night. Vendors will be allowed to setup Thursday the day before the event if traveling long distance or by noon Friday. Please, let us know on the application. **NO SETTING UP AFTER THE GATES OPEN, NO EXCEPTIONS!** No tarring down early without permission from the CEO or Event Coordinator.

Supplies: As we rent the facility that is used for this event, we must abide by their rules. All venues/parks/facilities are Green & Clean compounds. All Vendors are required to use paper compostable items. **NO GLASS containers** unless it's being sold as one of your vending items. Each vendor must clean their area before leaving. Anyone breaking the rules will be asked to leave. No dumping cooking grease/oil in portable restrooms. If you need to dump grease, we can arrange it at an additional fee.

Application Form: Please print clearly and fill out the application form completely. Incomplete applications will be returned or rejected. Include the Accident Waiver And Release of Liability Form.

Taxes: *It is the sole responsibility of the vendors to abide by all state sales and use tax regulations.*

ACCIDENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM

I HEREBY ASSUME ALL OF THE RISKS OF PARTICIPATING IN THIS EVENT, including by way of example and not limitation, any risks that may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them, or because of their possible liability without fault.

I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently prepared or trained for participation in this activity, and have not been advised to not participate by a qualified medical professional. I certify that there are no health-related reasons or problems which preclude my participation in this activity.

I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form will be used by the event holders, sponsors, and organizers of the activity in which I may participate, and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities at said activity. In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this activity, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows:

- (A) I WAIVE, RELEASE, AND DISCHARGE from any and all liability, including but not limited to, liability arising from the negligence or fault of the entities or persons released, for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft, or actions of any kind which may hereafter occur to me including my traveling to and from this activity, THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OR PERSONS: The Bikers And Needy Children Foundation, anyone they have leased property from or partnered with, and their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, and agents, and the activity holders, sponsors, and volunteers;
- (B) INDEMNIFY, HOLD HARMLESS, AND PROMISE NOT TO SUE the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made as a result of participation in this activity, whether caused by the negligence of release or otherwise. I acknowledge that The B.A.N.C. and their directors, officers, volunteers, representatives, and agents are NOT responsible for the errors, omissions, acts, or failures to act of any party or entity conducting a specific activity on their behalf. I acknowledge that this activity may involve a test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury, and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of participants, volunteers, monitors, and/or producers of the activity. These risks are not only inherent to participants, but are also present for volunteers. I hereby consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident, and/or illness during this activity. I understand while participating in this activity, I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video, or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the activity holders, producers, sponsors, organizers, and assigns.
